


Step by Step Instructions

Step 1 - Web Location

Head to https://touchfootball.etrainu.com/

Bottom right is the login area (Red Circle)

If you haven't already created a profile, please refer to the "Registration How To" guide.








Step 2 - Course Selection and Payment

Upon login click on "Training Library" (Red Circle)




This will take you to the course landing page, select "TFA - Referee Courses" (Blue Circle) Click "View Courses" (Black Circle)





After selecting course selection you will need to select "TFA - Level 1 Referee Touch Football Australia" (Red Circle) Select "Purchase" (Black Circle)








This will take you to the payment page.


Step 3 - Pre-Course work

The TFA Level 1 Referee and the Community Officiating General Principles (COGP) courses will appear in your "My Training" section (Red Circle).


Before accessing the Level 1 Referee course you will first need to complete the Community Officiating General Principles course. To enter the training select "View" (Purple Circle)

Community Officiating General Principles

Touch Football Australia (TFA) is committed to providing best practice in Australia in Sport Education. As such TFA has in place a Sport Education Framework (Framework), a copy of this framework can be found here.

Sport Australia has developed the Community Officiating General Principles (COGP) online course to assist officials in learning the basic skills they will need to officiate effectively. The COGP course is a prerequisite for the Level 1 TFA Referee course as outlined in the Framework and takes 2-4 hours to complete.

The COGP course is available free of charge to Australian Officials, and can be accessed through the Sport Australia learning portal which can be accessed here. If you don't already have an account, you will be required to create a login. Upon completion of the course you will receive access to your certificate.

Once you have received your certificate please click on the 'Take Assessment' button to upload a copy







If you are yet to complete the COGP course select "Start" (Black Circle)

Please skip the following step if you have previously completed the COGP course select "Take Assessment" (Red Circle) to upload your certificate.

The COGP is an external course provided by Sport Australia, to access it click "About the Course" (Red Circle) on the slide. To upload your certificate click "Take Assessment" (Black Circle).








Step 4 - Face to Face Course Enrolment






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To enrol in your course select "Start Course" (Pink Circle)



If there are no dates available that are suitable to your location, please email your state or regional office to register your interest.






Select the appropriate date for your course from the calendar (Example below)
